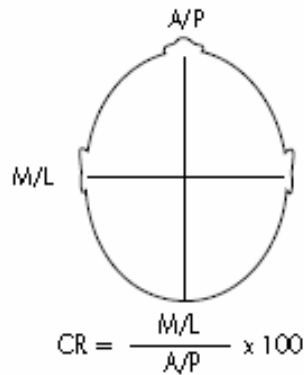


Brachycephaly Severity Scale



Level	Clinical Presentation	Recommendation	CR*
1 Normal	All symmetry with in normal limits	No treatment required	78% - 92.9%
2 Mild	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimal posterior flattening Slight bossing above the ears possible Slight posterior head height increase possible 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Repositioning program If 2 Month of repositioning has failed, cranial remolding orthosis at parent's request for cosmetic purposes 	93% - 96%
3 Moderate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Moderate to sever posterior flattening Minimal bossing above the ears and posterior head height increase 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Repositioning program or Cranial remolding orthosis-based on age and history 	96% - 99%
4 Severe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Severe posterior flattening Moderate bossing above the ears Moderate bossing above the ears and posterior head height increase 	Cranial remolding orthosis	99 - 102%
5 Very Severe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Severe posterior flattening Severe bossing above the ears and Severe posterior head height increase 	Cranial remolding orthosis	102 - 105%
